Day 1: Stakeholder Workshop 11th May 2016, Brussels (09.00-16.00)

‘Healthcare challenges and the underexploited role of innovation procurement (PPI/PCP)’

This stakeholder workshop will bring together key actors and those engaged in health (and social) care PPI and PCP projects, buyers and supply chain representatives and EC officers. It will review current state of the art, consider barriers and opportunities, and propose future calls to enable the wider adoption of innovation procurement as a mechanism to drive markets for healthcare innovation.

The workshop is specifically designed for participants in existing eHealth/healthcare projects concerned with the use of innovation procurement, public sector organisations interested in participating in future PP, PCP or CAS projects, suppliers of eHealth solutions and innovation agencies.

Topics will include key themes, new technologies and societal challenges in healthcare (ICT and eHealth, robotics), health and wellbeing (personalised medicine, healthy and active ageing, health and climate change).
